Eligibility

All listed qualifications are required.

- Residency in Manchester for at least six months duration immediately prior to the application deadline, April 9, 2010
- Graduate of Manchester High School, East Catholic High School, Howell Cheney Technical School, Cornerstone Christian School, Great Path Academy, or another secondary school in January or June of 2010
- Accepted into a college, university, community college, or other post-secondary school as a full-time student for the fall of 2010
- Ranked in top 65% of graduating class and have financial need

In addition to scholarships for students with financial need, a total of \$5,000 of MSF funds is available to divide among up to 10 students who are in the top 10% of their class and do not have financial need.

Criteria

- Demonstrated financial need
- Scholastic achievement
- School/community service and work experience

Awards

- Scholarships are for one year and are non-renewable
- Money is paid on a semester basis directly to the college
- Amount of individual awards will vary
- Applicants must notify the foundation of any change in school
- Scholarships will be presented at Awards Ceremony to be held at MCC on June 22, 2010

Applicants who qualify for this scholarship may also apply again for an award for the next year of post-secondary education or training, whether or not an award is received in 2010.
